

Left Page Assignment Choices

All Left Hand Pages (LHPs) must have Color With Purpose (CWP)

1. **Draw Pictures** which demonstrate the meaning of the words in the assignment. The word itself must appear in the picture.
2. Create **A Chapter Test** with a 10 question matching section & 4 multiple choice items.
3. **Make a Movie** that explains the meaning of the concepts.
4. Use Elements of Depth and Complexity to create a **Frame** of the content.
5. Choose the most important concepts in the assigned pages & write an explanation in 75 words or less that would explain the concept to a **Young Child**.
6. Choose a concept from the assigned pages & describe how this applies to a **“Real Life” Situation**. Make a comparison.
7. Make a set of **Flip-up, Taped-In Flashcards** with at least 8 words from the assigned pages. Write the word on the top of the flashcard. Write the definition and picture demonstrating the meaning underneath on your notebook paper.
8. Use Elements of Depth and Complexity, and Content Imperatives strung together, to **Write 5 High Level Questions** about the topic. (You don’t have to answer them.)
9. Create a **Concept Map** with a generalization or “big idea” in the middle. You must use at least 6 words or concepts to complete the map.
10. Write a **Letter To a Friend** explaining what you learned from the assignment.
11. Design a book or **Magazine Cover** that sparks interest in the subject for the assignment.
12. Create **A Comic Strip** that explains a major idea. Use at least 2 frames.
13. Create a **Word Search**. However, instead of word clues you must use definitions at the bottom and then find the word in the puzzle. (color coding works well)
14. **Write a Song** that helps explain at least 8 vocabulary words. It can be to a popular tune.
15. Surprise me. From the concepts that you recently learned, demonstrate your understanding by **Integrating** them in a new way for me. Make them rooms in a house, or instruments in a band, circus acts, rides in an amusement park, or something else of your own invention. Very important: make sure to show essential features, functions, and relations among concepts.
